Welcome Back to Term 2

It has been a great start to term 2 with over 70% of our students returning to school. Where we had originally planned to combine like year levels for this term, we have once again returned to our individual classroom programs due to the high number of students returning to school for face to face learning. Thank you to all the families who have already sent their child back to school.

The latest advice from the Education department and health authorities is that students are encouraged to return to school for term 2 learning.

I have included some brief notes to help you understand your responsibilities should you choose to keep your child at home during this time.

Any parents/families choosing to continue learning at home:

- Must ensure that their child has connected to the online Teams / Seesaw / Class Dojo for their respective class
- Must make daily contact with their teacher through this means. Where this is not possible, it can also be done through a phone call to the school and or a text to let the teacher know that your child is learning at home on that day.
- Must contact the school if their child is unwell as this will be recorded as illness and not required to engage in home learning on that day
- Students learning at home must participate in the online learning provided through teams and or paper based learning where necessary - this work needs to be submitted back to the class teacher for feedback and or assessment (study ladder is only required to be accessed if requested by the teacher) Should a take home pack be required (paper based) please contact your child's classroom teacher.
- Any child, where no communication has been received on that day, will be marked as absent and unexplained as per our normal attendance procedures until communication has been provided by the parent
- Must be able to be contacted by the school via phone/email/Teams/Seesaw or Class Dojo and ask that parents respond to requests and or missed phone calls.

We appreciate your support in ensuring that these procedures are followed to ensure that your child's learning continues whilst at home and is connected to the learning occurring in the class program at school.

We still have effective hygiene practices occurring at school including access to hand sanitizer throughout the school, soap in all wash areas, extra cleaning occurring throughout the day and also playground cleaning as well to ensure that our site remains safe for our community.

We ask at this stage that parents collecting their children from school to wait outside the classroom buildings as this allows greater space for adults to distance themselves.

We thank you for your continued support and look forward to more students returning to school in the coming days.
